

Chennai Set to Have Its First Luxury Mall



Designed on the lines of a classical Italian monument, Bergamo, spread over 40,000 square feet and costing more than Rs 10 crore will soon be the first luxury mall in Chennai.

Beyond Squarefeet, a boutique mall advisory company, will develop the project near Khader Nawaz Khan Road, along with KKA Builders Pvt Ltd. This bespoke retail space, slated to be ready by 2011, will house only premium international luxury brands. Exclusive services such as meet and greet hostesses, personal shopping advisors and concierge services will be some of its unique features.

Bergamo is the outcome of research into the possibilities for a quality luxury retail space in Chennai. The advisors envisaged that such a unique project would become a landmark in Chennai. The multi-colour, mosaic Duomo (dome) of Bergamo will soon be recognised as dome of luxury. The project is now open for lease and will be given to retailers for fit-outs in June 2011. Bergamo will open its doors in September 2011.
